We have had another busy month in June with our senior band playing in West Park and at St.
Laurence, whilst our training band gave a concert for the 1st Sawley Scout Group and then played for the Draycott Open Gardens event. Thank you to everyone who played at these concerts, especially our deps who covered for players on holiday or who were ill. Thank you especially to everyone who played in West Park in soaring temperatures: we had an audience of around 300; most of whom were sheltering from the sun under the trees – I wish we could have joined them! All our concerts in June have gone really well, with good audience

feedback and some good playing by both our bands. It augurs well both for the national finals and for the future of the band when some of our juniors are ready to move up.

Thank you to everyone who played at Peter Roebuck's funeral: there were nineteen of us in church (with players from both our bands), whilst I played the Last Post and Reveille at the graveside.
