After a busy time preparing for the national finals, we have some important concerts, whilst also needing to maintain our standard on the test piece for the NEMBBA contest. Thank you also to James for taking the rehearsals whilst I had a belated silver wedding anniversary holiday.

I am pleased with our performances at the proms concert for Longcliffe Golf Club and for the British Legion in St. Laurence. We are a little under-rehearsed still, as our focus has been on the test piece for so long now, but we are still

playing to a good standard, and I have received lots of great feedback from both our audiences. Thank you to our deps covering for players who had to be working or are on holiday: Chris, Catherine, Helen, Mike, Henry, Beardy Stu, and Ben.

We now have a week before both our bands compete at NEMBBA's autumn contest at The Whitworth in Darley Dale, and then we have the Winding Wheel and Remembrance parade. Adjudicator's Comments: Martin Heartfield

I) On Imber Down

Good opening. More dim at **6** please. **11** good soloist. **31** careful in accompaniment - only 'mf'. Semis into **49** are lost, careful with balance. **57** more accents in melody line needed. **78** 'fp' not fully effective. Good end to the movement.

II) The Church of St. Giles

Could be more 'pp' to open to capture the 'mysteriously' style. Good dynamic shape into **10**. Again the mp / p could be more relaxed for me. **22** good cornet. **29-35** quieter please. **35** much better control now and Euphs are good. Good build to **49**. **56** very atmospheric - troms a little loud. Lovely Euph solo. Excellent glock! More 'pp' to close please.

III) Imemerie Aeternum

A 'distant' feel to open and built well into **35**. **35** good, lots of detail. **41** good horns. **55** crescendo diminuendo troms not balanced. **63** a little untidy rhythmically. **75** - good full sound but careful accents don't become aggressive as we lose the triumphant feel. **103** only 'F' please. An exciting close.

Overall much to admire, some good solo contributions but some balance + tuning issues were noted. Some detail was lost where balance wasn't secure. The control in the quieter sections wasn't always successful. However a great sounding band. Thank you MD.

Rock On

Good opening. Good rhythmical feel and confidently played. Make sure that all notes are fully sustained. Good percussion. Good dynamics. Very enjoyable, thank you.

Eye of the Tiger

Again a good opening. **A** strong beat really helps from the percussion. **B** lovely controlled full sound. **F** accents could be stronger please.

Song Without Words

Accompaniment is good to open. Soloist plays with a lovely sound and a good sense of style. C accompaniment is well balanced D Accompaniment could be quieter please. H it is a little loud for me, needs to relax a bit. A great ending - bravo!

Over the Rainbow

A melody could be more sustained please. C tuning and balance is very good! Dynamic range is very controlled.

YMCA

A good tempo + rhythms drive to open. **A** accompaniment a little heavy for the melody. This is so much fun!! Again great percussion close and a very good dynamic range.
