Band Room News

Sharon Stansfield: 25 Years and Counting

On the 3rd January, our musical director Sharon Stansfield became the first resident conductor of the Long Eaton Silver Prize Band to have served for 25 years since the founding of the old Temperance Band in c. 1870. In doing so, she has exceeded the previous record held by the late Arthur Marshall who became the band's conductor on 27th July 1950 (following the death of Harry Evetts) until his resignation on 25th July 1975 (just two days short of 25 years).

Harry Evetts remains the band's longest serving conductor (between 1908 and 1950), but as the band's professional conductor, Harry Evetts only took rehearsals every two weeks, with much of the work left to a succession of bandmasters (the last of which was Arthur Marshall from c. 1948).

When Sharon took over the band was down to 15 players and 1 in the training group. Two months later the band came 17th of out of the 34 bands who entered the fourth section Midlands area, their best result for many years. Five national finals later (including becoming the only lady conductor so far to have won the third section National Championships of Great Britain in 2006), the total band membership now stands at 95, with 19 of the 34 regular players in our senior band having started in either our beginners' groups or our training band.

Ted Bradley

At our evening concert at the Chatsworth Centre, Ted Bradley was awarded a NEMBBA 80 long service award by our musical director and NEMBBA vice-president, Sharon Stansfield. We believe Ted is the first recipient of this award.

Ted is still a fine judge of music aged 89: he said that the euphoniums sounded superb – well done Debbie!

Paul

The band sends its best wishes to Paul, our solo trombonist, whose operation has been successful. We are hoping that Paul will be returning to us in September. Thank you to Carl, who is covering top trombone for us at NEMBBA and the area.

Helen Lane

Happy New Year to you all: my twenty-sixth with the band as your conductor!!! Thank you for my special award at our Christmas concert to mark my first 25 years as conductor of the band. Thank you too to Lisa and Roy who have also shared these 25 years with me.

Thank you for all your efforts during the Christmas season; as last year, 19 band jobs, starting with Ockbrook Christmas Lights and finishing on Christmas Eve at St. Laurence Church's Crib Service. Thank you especially to Roy, the band's "Spirit of Christmas" for leading the carolling at a number of our small band jobs, resplendent in his Christmas tie.

I had tremendous feedback from our concerts in St. Laurence and the Duchess Theatre where the tickets for next year are already selling quickly (over half had sold by the end of evening performance and as of now only 11 tickets are remaining for the matinee and 37 for the evening performance). Well done too to our award winners: Elaine, Nikki, Kate (twice) and Rob, and to Roy and Rob on their 25 years band long service awards, and of course Ted, who received his NEMBBA 80 years long service award, over 50 years of which have been spent with Long Eaton.

Both our bands are now working towards the NEMBBA contest and then the senior band to the area. Sadly, we are the only training band to have entered NEMBBA, but this remains an opportunity to show our fellow bandsmen how good we are, and what we have achieved in the 24 years since I took over conducting the training band (when it only had one player!). We are also starting to work on harder music in readiness for when some more of you will move up to the senior band.

Our senior band is still rebuilding after the loss of some experienced players, but we are going in the right direction again and we have made a good start on Arkansas, although we still have a long way to go with NEMBBA next Sunday and the area only a further three weeks away. Thank you to Henry and Ian who will be making their area debuts thus year, Jo, who is helping us out on euphonium, Andrew, who is playing bass trombone for us at NEMBBA and Beardy Stu, who is playing Eb Bass for us at the area.

For both bands, this is our opportunity to focus on our playing technique (the usual intonation, balance, starting and ending the correct notes together, dynamics and especially watching me for tempo changes), and being the very best that we can be.


